

Long-term transplant outcomes of:

- kidney and lung transplantation from DCDD are at least equivalent to those from DNDD.
- Liver transplant outcomes are lower with an increased incidence of primary non-function, and ischaemic type biliary strictures. Ischaemic cholangiopathy after transplant of DCDD livers occurs in 15–37% of recipients.
- DCDD hearts has been possible in recent years due to the pioneering work at St Vincent's Hospital Sydney in placing DCDD retrieved hearts on *ex-vivo* perfusion systems to preserve, resuscitate, assess and transport leading to world-leading results.
- DCDD whole pancreas are comparable to DNDD retrieved organs.
