New Zealand ICU Sepsis Admissions in 2024

Data from 19 contributing ICUs

55% of patients admitted to ICU with sepsis have septic shock

14% mortality for sepsis

19% mortality for septic shock

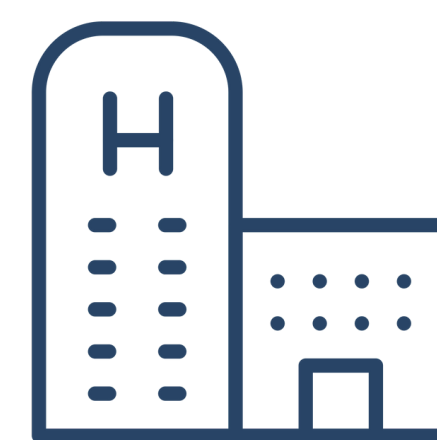
Quality Activity Participation

ICUs

- **83%** Antimicrobial Stewardship program
- **47%** ICU antibiograms
- **72%** Weekly infectious disease rounds

Hospitals

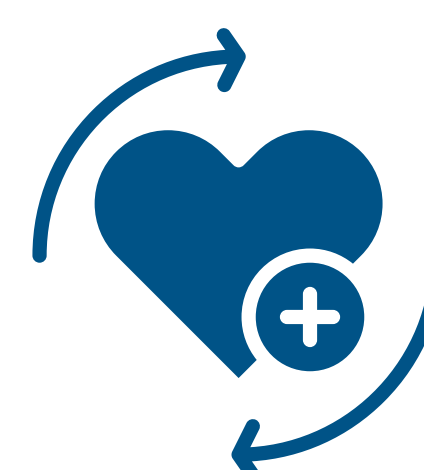
- **88%** Sepsis clinical pathway
- **12%** Sepsis care coordinators
- **19%** Sepsis survivor information



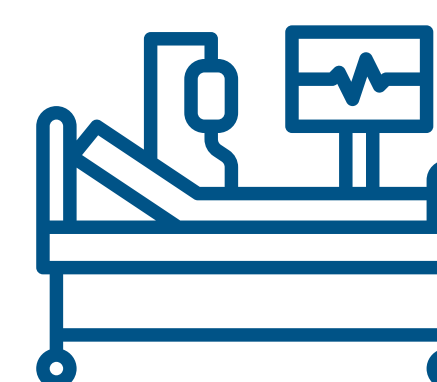
16% of all ICU admissions



83% required organ support



4% needed inpatient rehabilitation after hospital discharge



50% of all sepsis patients stay at least 2.6 days in ICU, compared with 1.8 days for non-sepsis patients



25% higher risk of ICU readmission within 6 months for ICU sepsis survivors (10% vs 8%)
