

## The Alfred-ANZICS Intensive Care Health Services Research Fellowship 2026

The Alfred Academic Centre and ANZICS fellowship is a 0.5 Full Time Equivalent Research Fellowship available for 6-12 months (equivalent to Academic Level A to C depending on applicant experience).

Applicants should have experience of working within the critical care environment and must be ANZICS members. Applicants from all relevant backgrounds including medical, nursing, allied health, health services personnel and health researchers are eligible. Although based in Melbourne, applications are also encouraged from all parts of Australia and New Zealand, with flexible working arrangements available.

The post is supported by The Alfred Intensive Care Data Science and Health Services Research Fund and by ANZICS. The successful applicant will work closely under the supervision of The ANZICS CORE management committee and leading researchers at The Alfred Intensive Care Academic Centre, part of Bayside Health.

### THE PROPOSED PROJECT

The inaugural Alfred-ANZICS Fellowship will focus on the development, reporting and implementation of “*Patient Reported Outcomes and Experience Measures*” for Intensive Care Units. The importance of these measures is widely recognised not only in ICU practice but throughout healthcare. A recent pilot study led by ANZICS in over 20 hospitals is now nearing completion.
